### German Foreign Trade Award

During the 7<sup>th</sup> German Foreign Trade Congress, which will take place on 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> November 2007 in the Congress Centrum Bremen, the German Foreign Trade Prize will be awarded for the fifth time. The award has immaterial value and honors outstanding corporate achievements in foreign trade, which base amongst others on strategic concepts for the opening of new markets, new international forms of co-operation and the use of new technologies for communication, organization and distribution. All companies which are operating on a transnational basis in the industry, trade and service sectors can apply.

#### Internet Leased Line in WTC Bremen

For a flat rate of € 25.00 net per month the WTC Bremen offers its tenants the opportunity to go online with two computers. The offered broadband internet connection (100 Mb symmetrical) is inbound 50 times faster than DSL and outbound 400 times faster (DSL: 2,000 kb inbound, 256 kb outbound; WTC: inbound & outbound 100,000 kb). Within the WTC-LAN the following maintenance services for availability and security are offered: Monitoring / security scan / intrusion detection / support for configuration and installation.
